The Back Country Horsemen of East Tennessee is a non-profit corporation working to preserve the historical use of recreational livestock on public lands, with an emphasis on volunteerism and conservation education.

Primarily a service organization, we work with the US Forest Service to enhance the trail riding opportunities in the Cherokee National Forest, from the Great Smoky Mountains to Virginia. We do this by providing suggestions for possible trails and by assisting with the physical work of clearing, digging and maintaining trails.

BCHET is an affiliate of the Back Country Horsemen of America, a national organization established in 1973. There are chapters in 20 states and over 600 members in Tennessee. Our members ride a wide variety of breeds and practice many different back country activities, primarily trail riding and horse camping.

By joining, you count yourself as someone who is interested in improving our trail riding opportunities. The number of members is all-important as we struggle to maintain the privilege of riding horses in National Forests.

All new memberships will be good through March 31 (or through next year if paid after March 31) and include membership in the national organization, Back Country Horsemen of America (BCHA). You will receive a quarterly BCHA newsletter and the BCHET newsletter.
